Established in 1962, Hartley Lifecare (Hartley) is a Canberra-based not-for-profit organisation providing supported accommodation for people with disability, their families and carers.

Originally founded to provide a learning facility and therapy support service for children and adults, Hartley has grown extensively to support people independently and in shared accommodation in over 30 locations. We offer a Hydrotherapy pool, and high quality adult respite services.

On 13 June 2025, Hartley transitioned from an incorporated association to a company limited by guarantee. This important step strengthens our governance and enables us to meet growing demand beyond the ACT, including the ability to deliver services in New South Wales.

Hartley Lifecare relies on NDIS (National Disability Insurance Scheme) funding, corporate partners, individual donors and special events to expand and enhance the services we provide we provide to people living with disability in our local community.

OUR PHILOSOPHY

At Hartley, our philosophy is built on empowering people with disability and their families to shape their own support. We focus on person-centred care, family involvement, and active support, ensuring every individual's needs, choices, and aspirations are at the centre of everything we do.

Person Centred

Person centred approach is about ensuring the person with disability is at the centre of decisions which relate to their life. People with disability have control and are involved in planning, developing and monitoring support to make sure it meets their individual needs.

Putting people and their families at the centre of decision making is a core focus for Hartley. We also train our staff in active support and implement this model across our support service for the best outcome for the person with disability.



Family Governance

Hartley Lifecare applies a Family Governance model to all of the services we provide, allowing the person supported and their families to be involved in determining the care requirements as much or as little as they like.

It is crucial for us to be able to provide appropriate support through listening to each individual in an effort to fully understand their needs. This involves working closely with those who have a greater level of awareness of the individual's life experiences. Through ongoing feedback we are able to properly support the individual and help them to achieve their goals and aspirations.


Active Support
