Our STA Services

Hartley Lifecare provides person centred respite care (short term accommodation) to people with disability. Residential respite care is 24/7 care in specialist disability accommodation for a short period of time.

STA guests will receive around the clock, high quality services in the comfort and safety of our state of the art, custom built STA facilities.

The relationship between a carer and their family or friend can take a physical and emotional toll on each person. STA allows both parties to be able to take 'time out' with real peace of mind.
